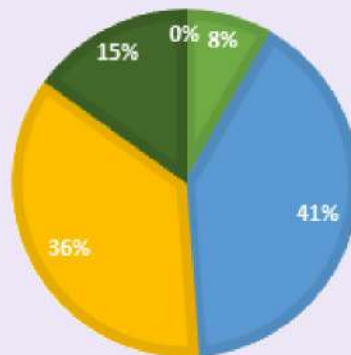

Q1. CURRICULUM AND SYLLABI OF THE COURSES ARE IN HIGH STANDARDS

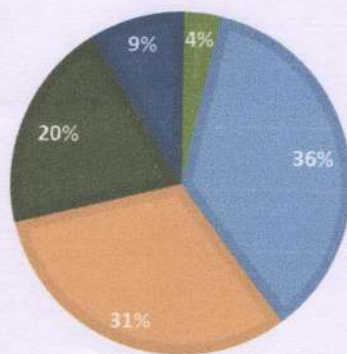

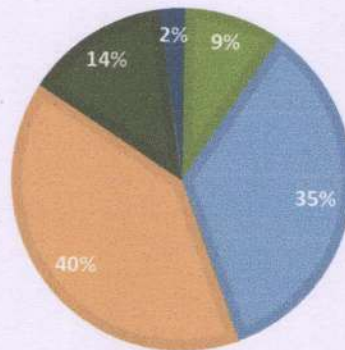

Q3. UNITS IN THE SYLLABUS ARE RELEVANT TO THE COURSE

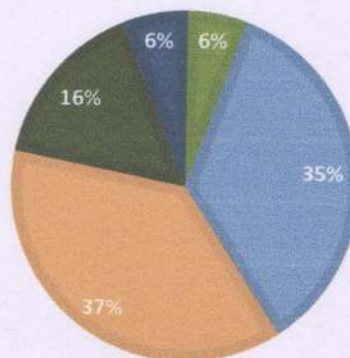

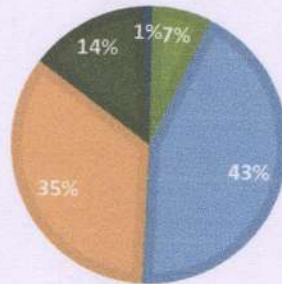

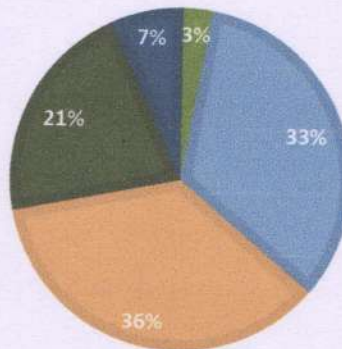

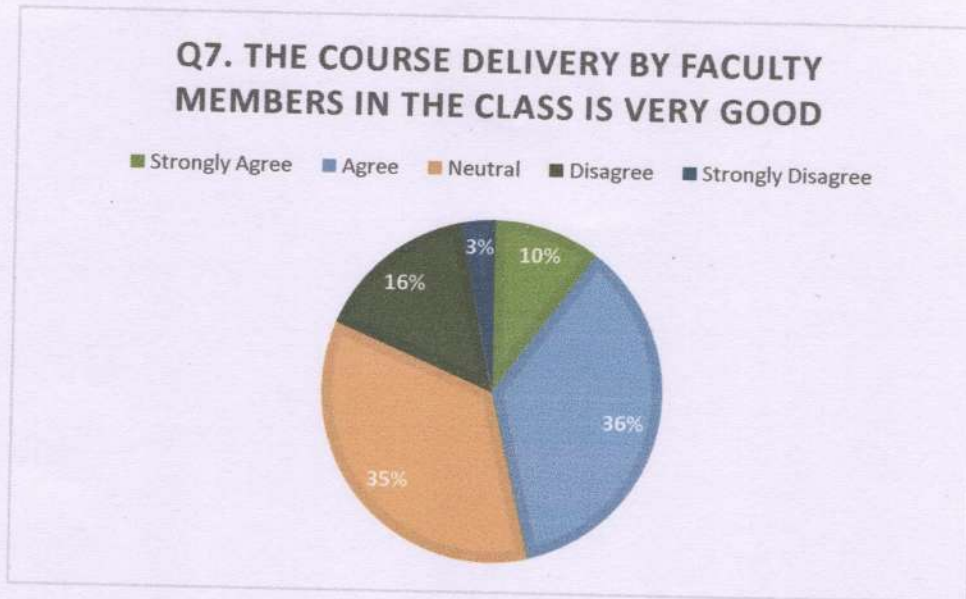
Q6. SYLLABUS IS FREQUENTLY UPDATED TO MEET THE DEMANDS OF THE STUDENTS

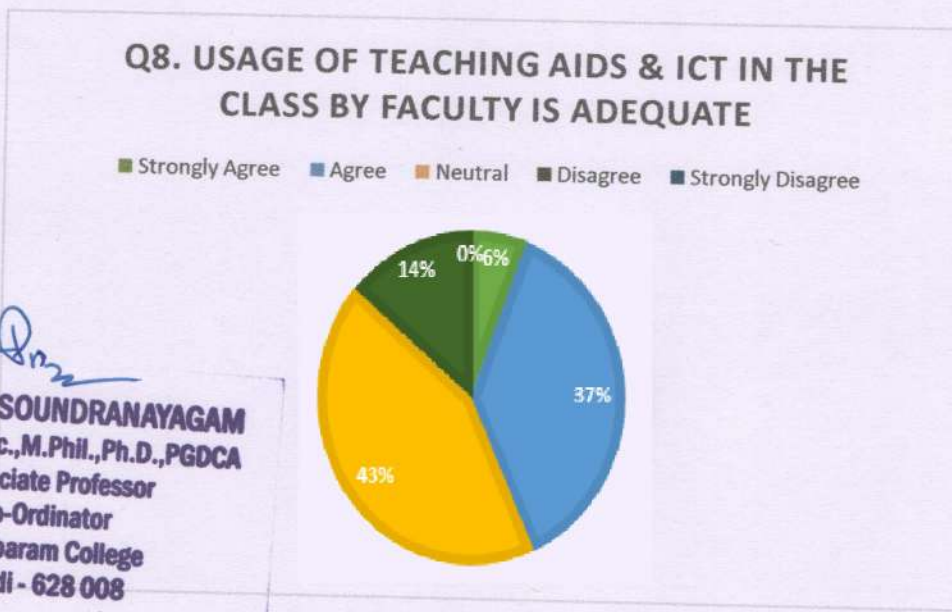




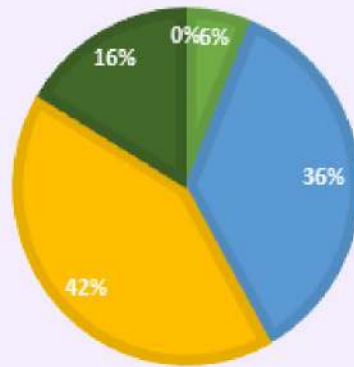

Q9. FACULTY WERE ABLE TO DELIVER ON-LINE LECTURES EFFECTIVELY

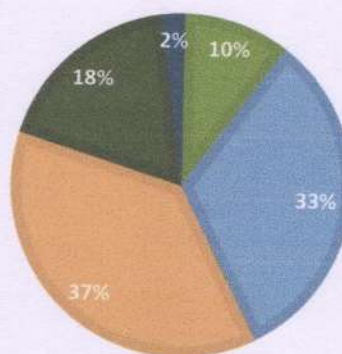
