






This chart shows that a vast majority of the faculty consider the academic environment favorable for effective teaching.




This chart shows that a majority of the faculty feel that the college time-table has lot of scope for adjustment as per requirements.




This chart shows that the majority of the faculty feel that the college library is highly resourceful.




This chart shows that the vast majority of the faculty concur that the recommended books are made available from the college library.




This chart shows that the faculty agree that the infrastructure for giving lectures using ICT is adequate and efficient.






This chart shows that the faculty consider the campus safe and secure. This is obvious from the vast majority of the faculty choosing to answer as 'excellent'.
